IMPORTANT NOTES

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- # This quotation is based on a minimum hire period of two (2) weeks. The total hire charge will depend on the full / actual hire period.
- # Prices are exclusive of GST.
- # Trading terms are strictly net 14 days.

CONDITIONS

- # Beachside Scaffolds cannot be held responsible for delays in delivery, erection, relocation, dismantle or collection due to inclement weather.
- # The Customer is responsible to ensure that the surface on which the scaffold is to be built has adequate load bearing capacity to support the loads due to the scaffolding.
- # The Customer is responsible for the raising/lowering/moving of hop-up brackets and associated planking as required and to be responsible for costs of same.
- # The Customer is to be responsible for workers safety if any item of scaffolding is removed or altered. Please refer to WorkCover OHS Acts.
- # The Customer is to make good, clean, level ground for continuous sole boards.
- # The Customer is to make provision for scaffold ties at required positions and waterproof same. The may require the Customer to notify residents to leave windows open for scaffold ties.
- # The Customer is responsible to obtain all Council, Engineers, WorkCover and other local and statutory authority's approvals and fees where applicable and be responsible for costs of same unless requested in writing that we do.
- # The Customer is to be responsible for the supply, erection and removal on completion of protective casings/hoarding/barriers and signage in areas of public access and to be responsible for costs of same when require unless otherwise requested.
- # The Customer is responsible for the covering of all electrical wiring within 4.5m of the scaffold prior to commencement of erection of scaffolding.
- # This price does not include hoardings, overhead protection or shade cloth unless specifically requested in writing.
- # The hire rate incorporates downtime during relocations or equipment, public holidays, RDO's productivity days and inclement weather.
- # Hire commences on date of delivery and continues during dismantling and re-erect period.
- # All prices on this quotation are based on work to be carried out during normal working hours (Mon to Fri; 7.00am to 3.00pm). Labour performed outside these hours will incur additional costs to cover penalty rates.
- # This quotation is based on the site and access to remain clear of obstacles. Any hazards introduced to the area requiring additional labour to erect scaffold will incur an additional charge.
- # If an Engineers Certificate is required a fee of \$600 (excl GST) is applicable.
- # This quote is based on the fee use of cranes or other hoisting equipment for the depositing and removal of our scaffolding at various levels as required on site.
- # Forty eight (48) hours notice is required for dismantling of scaffolding.
- # Please note that the Customer is liable for the cost of replacing any unreturned equipment as well as the cost of repairing any damaged equipment. Equipment must be returned in the same condition as it was received during cleaning. Equipment returned that requires cleaning will be charged to the Customer.
- # To avoid disputes about verbal orders or variations, all additions or variations must be in writing accompanied by a signed company purchase order or authority before any work is conducted.
- # Invoicing is on a weekly basis; our terms are net 14 days and come under the Security of Payment Act 1999.
